Harstine Island Women's Club Scholarship Judy and Charles Chase Scholarship Fund For Harstine Island Residents

The Harstine Island Women's Club is accepting scholarship applications from **full time Harstine Island residents** of any age graduating from or having graduated from an accredited high school or who have obtained a diploma from an accredited high school program or GED by August 2025. Applications may be submitted yearly.

Scholarships are available for academic, vocational, or continuing education for the 2025-26 school year.

Scholarship evaluations are based upon the Harstine Island Women's Club procedures and include the following considerations: commitment of purpose, qualities of citizenship and leadership, contribution to the community, academic achievement, and ability to communicate plans and objectives. In the event of ties, interviews may be conducted.

Scholarships will be paid directly to the student's school of choice upon the club's receiving proof of the recipient's enrollment. If the student enrolls in an on-line or correspondence course and must pay directly at the time of enrollment, the club will reimburse the student up to the amount of the scholarship upon receipt of proof of enrollment.

Applications are available from school counselors at Olympic Community College (Shelton & Bremerton), South Puget Sound Community College, The Evergreen State College, and North Mason, Shelton, CHOICE and Cedar High Schools, and Gravity Learning Center.

- **3.** At least three dated letters of recommendation which includes relationship to applicant. One recommendation is required to be recent (dated within six months of the date of this application).
- 4. Most recent school transcripts.
- 5. Copy of state driver's license or current ID card.
